

Gifts and hospitality

A comprehensive Lymphoma Action gifts and hospitality policy is available. Please ask your staff contact.

Volunteers must follow Lymphoma Action's policy on gifts, hospitality and anti-bribery, which reflects legal requirements and the organisation's ethics.

Offer of a gift or hospitality

If you are offered any gift or hospitality in the course of your role, other than what has been agreed as part of your volunteering activity, for example collecting items for a tombola, you should contact your staff contact to discuss it before the gift or hospitality is formally accepted or declined. Tell the person offering it that you appreciate the gesture but, as a volunteer, you will need to check with Lymphoma Action whether the gift/hospitality can be accepted.

No gift or hospitality can be accepted where there is any suggestion that a favour in return is expected or implied. All gifts and hospitality must be in kind and not in cash.

Offering others gifts or hospitality

Volunteers must not offer any gift or hospitality without the prior approval of your staff contact.
