- Every 26 minutes someone is diagnosed with lymphoma in the UK
- Lymphoma is the UK's 5th most common cancer
- Lymphoma is the most common cancer in teenagers and young adults (15 to 24 years old)
- Lymphoma is a type of blood cancer that develops when white blood cells called lymphocytes grow out of control
- There are no known causes of lymphoma
- Lymphoma is a complex disease there are over 60 different subtypes
- The aim of most lymphoma treatments is to send the lymphoma into remission
