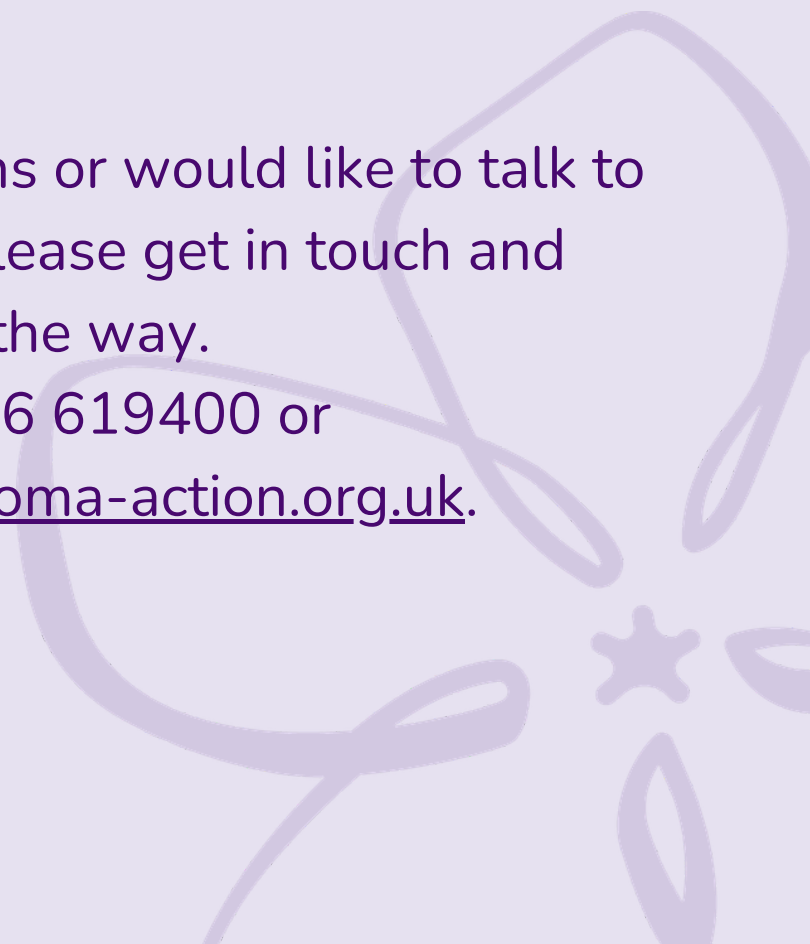
Remembering your loved one

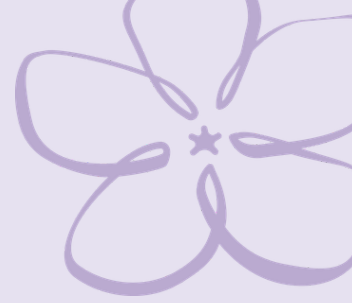

At the funeral service or celebration of life, you may wish to collect donations in person, using our collection boxes.

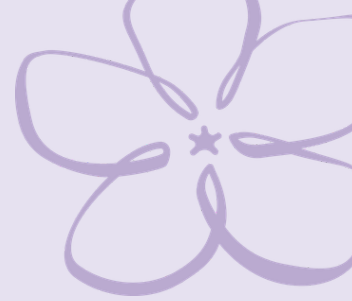
You may also wish to create an online tribute space - please refer to the next page of this guide for help on how to do this.

MuchLoved will automatically create a link to your loved one's page and a QR code that you can share with family and friends and may wish to add to the Order of Service.

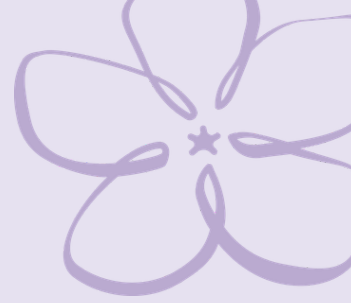

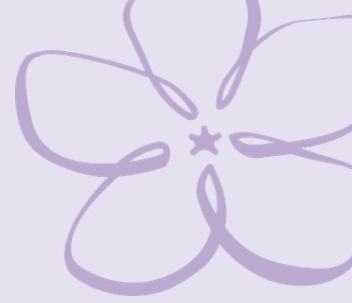

Each flower is unique - delicately hand crafted and available in purple, pink or teal. They can be used as garden ornaments or inside your home, as a permanent memorial to your loved one.

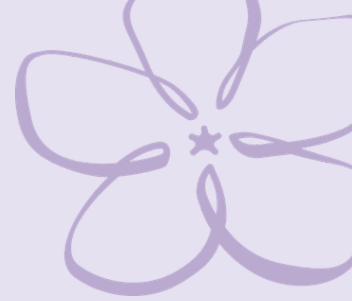

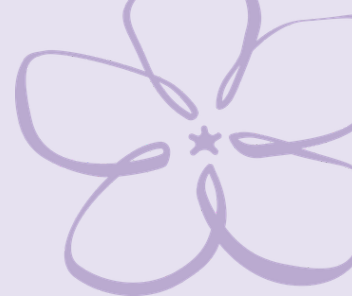
