Volunteers have / had lymphoma **80%**

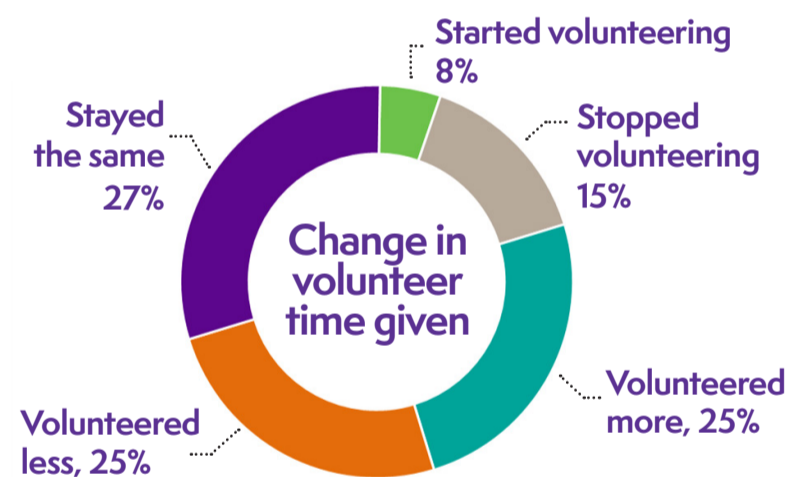
Volunteers who work full or part time hours **43%**
